HORNET CARE

PURPOSE

Hornet Care is a partnership between Azle ISD and Parker County Hospital District Outreach Program, to provide medical care onsite at each campus. Through the use of telemedicine and the Medpod Medical Cart, the healthcare needs of staff and students can be met in a convenient setting with each campus nurse. Hornet Care's purpose is to increase the educational success of students and staff by assuring access to healthcare. Early treatment can decrease the need for expensive medical care and unnecessary Emergency Room visits.

Is Treatment Available to Everyone?

To receive treatment the student or staff member must be enrolled. Registration must be completed online or a paper consent filled out prior to treatment.

Staff: \$30 visit fee will be collected at time of service. Paid by credit card/FSA card only. Commercial insurance will be billed for services provided when possible.

Students:

Students with private health insurance or are covered under Medicaid will have provided PCHD with that information during enrollment. Copayment will vary and be discussed prior to visit.

If a student does not have health insurance, we will provide them with options.

What is HORNET CARE?

- Telemedicine health care provided at all Azle ISD schools utilizing the Medpod Medical cart.
- Only students and staff at Azle ISD can be served at this time.

Did you know?

- HORNET CARE can connect your child to medical care while they remain in school.
- We can treat sore throats, earaches, colds, skin rashes, eye infections, etc...
- Rapid Flu, Strep and COVID tests can be done on site at each campus.
- Prescriptions if needed can be sent electronically to the pharmacy of your choice.

How do I enroll in HORNET CARE?

- Visit www.pchdtx.org click on School Based Health Care logo then on the Azle ISD logo and follow the enrollment directions.
- Pick up a consent form at school and return it to the school nurse.

When is HORNET CARE open?

• Monday—Friday during regular school hours

Does a parent/guardian have to be present?

- A parent/guardian will always be contacted prior to student being seen to give consent.
- Parent/Guardian can be present during the visit or can be updated when the visit is finished.
