The University of Texas at Austin's OnRamps dual enrollment program provides opportunities for high school students to earn college credit. OnRamps is designed to accelerate student success by providing university-level work and develop skills necessary for college. Students are able to experience college before college!

Why OnRamps?

- > Convenience OnRamps : > Transferable OnRamps coursework offers UT within a high school · classroom
 - courses transfer to public colleges and universities in Texas and beyond
- : > Cost Effective UT core courses at a significant discount for the same course taken on campus

- > Preparation Students gain early exposure, easing the transition from high school to colllege
- > Access Students are exempt > Low Risk Students may drop from TSI requirements for: OnRamps courses
 - the college enrollment at any time without penalty

How does OnRamps work?

Students are enrolled in a yearlong university-level learning experience taught by a UT-trained high school teacher on our high school campus. Students experience curriculum designed by faculty at The University of Texas at Austin. Students can earn three or six hours of UT credit, with feedback and assessment provided by UT course staff.
